Recommended Packing Options

- Boots (waterproof are best)
- PolarTec-Type fleece Over-Garments (best) or Wool (good)
- Sleeping Bags
- Portable Camp Stove with fuel
- Matches and / or lighters (waterproof matches are best)
- Coffee Pot, Filters & Coffee
- Stew Pot (with lid for heating water), Skillet, Sauce Pan
- Cooking Utensils, Flatware, Can Opener
- Sharp Utility Knife, Fillet Knife
- Plates, Bowls, Cups
- Paper Towels & Toilet Paper
- Dish Towels & Pot Holders
- Dish Soap & Scrubber
- Bath Towels & Soap
- Sturdy Trash Bags
- First Aid Kit
- Clothing, Toiletries, Personal Items

Additional Packing Options

- Lantern (propane or kerosene)
- Air Mattress or Foam Pad
- Flotation Devices (for boating)
- Fishing Poles & Tackle
- Outboard Motor (4-5hp with fuel and basic tools)
